DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

This is a USDA Grant to rebuild a retaining wall out of wood and stones that is subject to town drainage water. The town will be receiving a check for \$12,000 for dumpster costs. FEMA is requiring the Town to get flood insurance for its buildings or they will not cover future losses. He further explained the middle class STAR program. A card will be sent out in the mail notifying people about it.

Mr. Maloney also reported that the proposed settlement for United Parcel Service pertaining to 2005, 2006 & 2007 assessed value is agreeable. The total cost to the town is estimated to be \$2,700.00 plus interest and will be offset with \$9,500 non-compliance fee that the court awarded the town, so this will cost the taxpayers nothing.

Public hearing for the application of El Dorado LLC at 1987 Ulster Avenue.

Mr. Clayton Van Kleeck and Mr. Steve Kaka gave a brief overview of the project and answered some brief questions. The proposal calls for removing the current standing building and adding a 3,600 square foot convenient mart with gas pumps. The project was reviewed by the County Planning Board and was given positive approval with no corrections or suggestions (a first for the county). The pump station will have a four pump set up. The canopy over the gas pumps was designed to reduce light pollution. The lights are angled downward. The project was designed to meet or exceed the standards of the Town Code. The store would be rented out. The parking lot will be shared with the current Van Kleeck's Tires. There is ample parking spaces for all the businesses. The siding will be a mortar type with a color design that complements the current tire business. The business will not be a 24 hour operation.

Legislator Mr. Michael Berardi and Brian Cahill stated that they are in favor of the project.
